Collaboration Guide

ORDER OF OPERATION

1. Predictor – Makes prediction
2. Reader Leader – Reads text while everyone follows along
3. Questioner - Takes team through the questions and gets everyone's input
4. Synthesizer - Leads team by connecting each exhibit to the Essential Question

THE PREDICTOR

My role is to:

- Use the questions, title & document appearance to predict what the exhibit might be about.
- You can change your mind & make new predictions as you read on.

Useful Phrases:

"Based on the pictures/graphs/charts, I think this is going to be about..."

"Based on _____, I think this section is going to be about..."

THE READER LEADER

My role is to:

- Read the text aloud to the group
- Make sure everyone reads along
- Organize materials
- Make sure no one writes on materials from files

Useful Phrases:

"I'm going to start reading so everyone follow along."

"Okay, let's get started with the reading."

THE QUESTIONER

My role is to:

- Read questions when it's time to answer them
- Get everyone's input before agreeing on an answer

Useful Phrases:

"Question 1 says... What do you think is a good answer?"

"Does everyone agree?" or "Does anyone disagree?"

"So what do we think the answer is?"

"How should we write the answer?"

THE SYNTHESIZER

My role is to:

- Lead the team in relating the exhibit to the essential question

Useful Phrases:

"How does the exhibit help answer the essential question?"

"What argument does this exhibit support?"

"Is this evidence reliable? Can it be used to support an argument?"
