ORDER OF OPERATION

1. Reader Leader - Assigns roles
2. Predictor – Makes prediction
3. Reader Leader – Reads
4. Questioner - Takes team through the questions
5. Synthesizer - Leads team through relating the exhibit to the Essential Question
6. Reader Leader - Selects reader leader for next station

THE READER LEADER

My role is to:

- Decide who will do each job
- Read the text aloud to the group
- Make sure everyone reads along
- Organize materials
- Make sure no one writes on materials from files

Useful Phrases:

"Did everyone get the answer written down?"

THE PREDICTOR

My role is to:

- Use the questions, title & document appearance to predict what the exhibit might be about.
- You can change your mind & make new predictions as you read on.

Useful Phrases:

"Let's hear what...thinks."

"For this round, let's have ____ be the predictor &..."

"Did everyone get the answer written down?"

THE QUESTIONER

My role is to:

- Read questions when it's time to answer them
- With the Summarizer, encourage the group to help summarize the answers

Useful Phrases:

"Question 1 says... What do you think is a good answer?"

THE SYNTHESIZER

My role is to:

- Leads the team in relating the exhibit to the essential question

Useful Phrases:

"How does the exhibit help answer the essential question?"

"What argument does this exhibit support?"
